

WALTER R. COURTENAY AWARD

It is my privilege to introduce a special award to be presented annually to two of the most outstanding Eagle Scouts in the Middle Tennessee Council. An anonymous donor has generously donated the capital to perpetuate a gift of \$1,000.00 to each recipient. The award will be called the Walter R. Courtenay Eagle Scout Award in honor of Dr. Courtenay, the long-time pastor of First Presbyterian Church of Nashville, Tennessee, and zealous supporter of Scouting.

All Eagle Scouts who were approved by an Eagle Board of Review during the calendar year are eligible for the awards. Financial need is not a consideration for this award. The awards will be presented at the Council's annual Eagle Scout Volunteer Recognition Reception.

The recipient of the Walter R. Courtenay Eagle Scout Award shall:

1. Be of exemplary moral character.
2. Be, or have been, very active in his troop, the Order of the Arrow, Camp Staff, NYLT Staff, and in other Scouting leadership opportunities.
3. Be active in extra-curricular activities in his school and church, such as sports, drama, and music.
4. Be outstanding academically.
5. Be held in high esteem by his fellow Scouts.
6. Be a Leader!

We also are requesting the following items from each applicant:

1. A letter of recommendation from the applicant's Scoutmaster or Troop Committee Chairman.
2. A list of all merit badges earned by the applicant.
3. A copy of the Applicant's Eagle Project write-up that was a part of his Eagle Scout application.
4. Any additional letters of recommendation from persons outside the Scouting Movement. (These letters are optional)

ALL OF THE REQUESTED INFORMATION MUST BE MAILED TO THE EAGLE REGISTRAR by January 31, 2017.

After the committee has reviewed all applications and enclosures, it reserves the right to interview one or more applicants to assist in making its final decision. On behalf of the selection committee, I thank you in advance for your assistance with the selection process.
