What is NYLT?

National Youth Leadership Training is an action-packed, exciting program designed to provide youth members of the Middle Tennessee Council, Boy Scouts of America, with leadership skills and experience that they can use in their home units and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others.

Participants learn and practice Goal Setting, Planning, Problem Solving, Decision Making, and Conflict Resolution through classes, games, and outdoor activities. Participants learn to use the Leading EDGE and the Teaching EDGE by working with their patrols in an exciting and challenging course environment.

Who May Attend?

A scout or Venturer must have the following qualifications by June 1, 2017:

Boy Scouts – *Must be a current member of BSA *Be 13 years of age and have completed the 8th grade *Be a First Class Scout

Venturers - *Must be 13 years of age and have completed the 8th grade *Must have completed the ILSC training prior to this training.

Exceptions will not be made for the age or rank requirements. Each Participant must bring a completed Health & Medical Record form (signed by a doctor & guardian) in order to participate in the course.

Details

Participants for the May 28-June 2 course should plan to arrive at Latimer at 11:30 AM on Sunday, May 28th. Participants will be ready to depart at 7:30 P.M. on Friday, June 2nd. Participants for the May 29-June 3 course should plan to arrive at Latimer at 11:30 AM on Monday, May 29th. Participants will be ready to depart at 7:30 P.M. on Saturday, June 3rd. Your first meal is dinner on arrival day.

- The cost is \$225.00 for the week.
- Those who are recommended by their Scoutmaster or Crew Advisor as meeting the above requirements should send a **\$100.00 deposit and a completed, signed application** to the Council Service Center as soon as possible. Enrollment will be limited to 48 participants (eight patrols). Priorities and restrictions may be made to maintain demographic balances. By mid-May, all participants should receive a letter with a list of items to bring and other details.

Special Note: Latimer Reservation is located just outside of Spencer, TN approximately 125 miles east of Nashville and participants are required to stay through the entire course in order to receive credit for completion of the training so CHECK YOUR SCHEDULES CAREFULLY!

Participants will be required to perform outdoor cooking several times during the week.
