By submitting this form, I certify that I have completed the required prerequisite training for my position in Scouting. Registration is limited, so send in this form or, preferably, follow the link on the www.mtcbsa.org website to register.

Prerequisites

- Be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America
 - Complete Youth Protection, Fast Start, This is Scouting, all Leader Specific Training for your registered position (including appropriate Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills, for those who are Scoutmasters)
 - Must be capable of functioning safely in an outdoor environment
 - Annual BSA Health & Medical Record Parts A, B & C signed by a certified or licensed healthcare provider.
- Participants will be sent a packet in July containing information that will help prepare for the course. This packet will also include an equipment list, a personal resource survey and important course information.

Cost

The course fee is \$235.00, which covers all instructional materials and all food for the course (except for two meals provided by the patrols). Each participant will receive three course shirts, cap and training neckerchief. The fee also covers the Wood Badge Award that is presented on completion of the ticket. A minimum fee deposit of \$99.00 is due with the application, with the remaining balance due by July 21, 2017. Refund requests must be submitted to the council office no later than 10 days before your arrival at camp. No refunds are considered after the ten day mark. Any refund given will be less a \$30 cancellation fee. Exceptions will be made for medical reasons with a doctor's note.

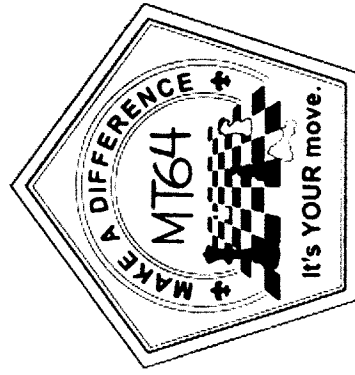
Recognition

Upon successful completion of the ticket, participants are entitled to receive recognition, which consists of the Wood Badge beads (two wooden beads on a leather thong), a tan neckerchief, a leather woggle and a certificate. The recognition items not only identify a Scouter who has completed advanced training, but remind the wearer of an ongoing commitment to continued service to Scouting.

Goals of Wood Badge

- Learn techniques to make us better leaders, and how to lead groups to achieve objectives.
- View Scouting globally, as a family of interrelated, values-based programs that provide age-appropriate activities for youth.
- Learn valuable leadership concepts that we can use, not only in Scouting, but in our homes and workplaces.

- Revitalize our commitment by sharing in an overall inspirational experience that helps provide Scouting with the leadership it needs to accomplish its mission on an ongoing basis.
